Description: VIP currently supports AmeriCorps with national outreach for the National Civilian Community Corps NCCC and FEMA Corps programs in all states and territories. This contract includes program development, implementation and management, along with the development of a registration system, program website, marketing materials (print and digital), social media management, video presentations, public presentations, and coordination with community agencies/non-profits/stakeholders. A focal point of this program is to recruit young Veterans who are underemployed or unemployed to serve as team leaders in the NCCC and FEMA Corps. Additional emphasis is placed on outreach to high school and college students of military families to serve in these programs. Participants serve for 10 months as they receive leadership and job skills training, and educational awards to pay for continuing education and job training, or to repay student loan debt. This program requires the extensive development of educational, outreach and marketing materials in print and digital formats, as well as in English and Spanish languages.

Description of Service: VIP provides personnel that are certified by the NWS to take, document, and disseminate upper air radiosonde, Rawin-Rabal comparative observations at each observing site specified. All services conducted in connection with the performance of this contract shall be in accordance with the Federal Meteorological Handbook (FMH) Number 3 and NWS Manual 10-1401 and other applicable procedures and directives. Radiosondes provide upper-air data that are essential for weather forecasts and research. A radiosonde is a balloon-borne instrument that measures and transmits meteorological data of temperature, pressure, and humidity. A theodolite is an instrument used to track a radiosonde. Contract management and administrative duties are required under this contract. This includes reviewing documentation, collecting data, issuing reports, monthly deliverables, maintaining site supplies inventory, generating time sheets, and coordinating schedules across shifts 365 days per year.
